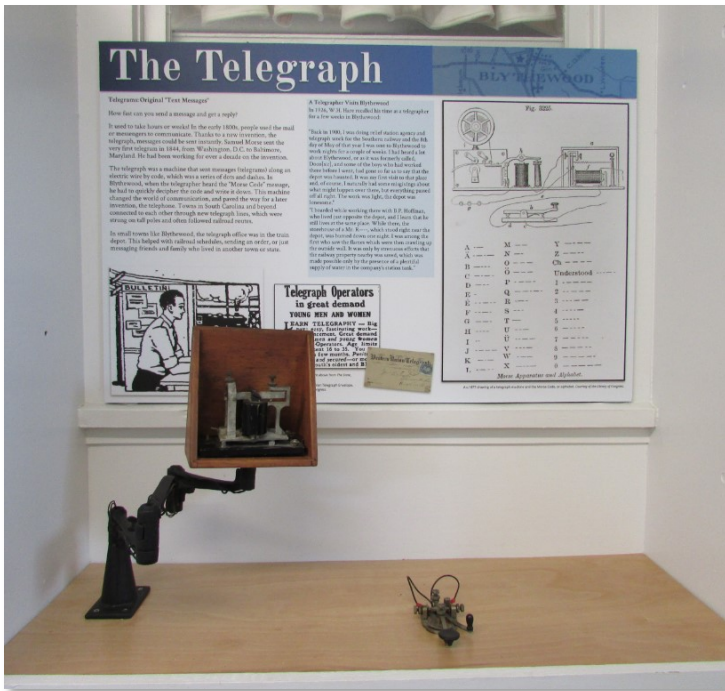
Although the Blythewood Historical Society and Museum is not a children's museum, there are plenty of things for kids to see.
